## Holy Spirit Power for Our Times Part 10: Write The Vision, Run & Persist With It

1. Write Down Your God-Given Vision Divine vision shown = revelation "Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint; but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction."

Proverbs 29:18 NIV

# 1. Write Down Your God-Given Vision "Then the Lord answered me and said: "Write the vision And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it."

Habakkuk 2:2 NKJV

1. Write Down Your God-Given Vision "For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry." Habakkuk 2:3 NKJV

## Joseph & His Brothers

- Takes time: Often must mature first
- Beware of discouragement
- God's enemy (the devil) is against you and uses people

2. Beware the Vision/Dream Killers "Now his brothers had gone to graze their father's flocks near Shechem, 13and Israel said to Joseph" Genesis 37:12-13 NIV

"As you know, your brothers are grazing the flocks near Shechem. Come, I am going to send you to them." "Very well," he replied." Genesis 37:13 NIV

"So he said to him, "Go and see if all is well with your brothers and with the flocks, and bring word back to me." Then he sent him off from the Valley of Hebron."

Genesis 37:13 NIV

"But they saw him in the distance, and before he reached them, they plotted to kill him. 19"Here comes that dreamer!" they said to each other." Genesis 37:18 NIV

# 2. Beware the Vision/Dream Killers "As they sat down to eat their meal, they looked up and saw a caravan of Ishmaelites coming from Gilead." Genesis 37:25 NIV

"Judah said to his brothers, "What will we gain if we kill our brother and cover up his blood?" Genesis 37:26 NIV

prophets." Matthew 16:14 NIV
